Fences will not exceed 2'6". Entry fee: £15

Prizes: 1st £30, 2nd £25, 3rd £20, 4th £15.

Class 3 OPEN Kindly sponsored by Hudds Farm Livery Stables

Fences will not exceed 3'0". Entry fee: £15

Prizes: 1st £30, 2nd £25, 3rd £20, 4th £15.

Start at approx. 12:30hrs

This class is a qualifier for the Finals of the BHS Cross Country Championships 2010.

Class 4 FUN TEAM CHASE Kindly sponsored by Wadworth Brewery.

Teams of up to 4 Entry fee: £50 per team

At least 3 horses must complete the course to qualify. Timed Section will apply. Teams may ride either the Novice or the Open course, but all team members must jump the same course.

Prizes: 1st £100; 2nd £80; 3rd £50; Rosettes to 6th place.

Start at approx. 3:00 pm.

Class 5 THE AVON VALE HUNT FUN SCURRY

The course will be approximately 2.5miles over natural hunting obstacles. Maximum height of any fixed obstacle will not exceed 4ft 6in. Horses must be upwards of 15HH and jockeys must be at least 16 years old on the day of the race. Jockeys will be asked to sign a disclaimer on the day of the race.

Entry fee £30 per horse

Prizes in kind will be given to the highest placed lady and gentleman finishers.

ENTRIES WILL CLOSE on Tuesday 30th March 2010, or when classes are full. Late entries, room permitting, Class 2 £3 extra, Classes 1, 3 and 4 £5 extra. No entries will be accepted without the correct fee.

Due to increased costs of Red Cross services, a £3 donation per competitor is required for Red Cross Ambulance cover.

There will be a timed section, kindly sponsored by **Neston Park Farm Shop**, to include a chicane to be negotiated. In the event of a tie, the fastest competitor (or team in Class 4) through the timed section will be the winner.

In the Fun Team Chase, at least 3 of the team must be in the designated area before the first rider leaves the area. In the pairs both riders must be in the designated area before the first rider leaves the area. Time will be determined from the time of the first horse into the timed section to the time of the third horse out of the section in the fun team chase and the second horse out in the pairs.

RULES

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. No horse may run more than once in a class.
3. All competitors are responsible for making way for, and not impeding, overtaking competitors, especially in the Timed Section. Inconsiderate riding leading to obstructing another competitor could lead to elimination, at the judge's discretion.
4. Any competitor who retires or is eliminated must leave the course at a walk.
5. Crash helmets and body protectors are to be worn by all competitors.
6. If at any time during the competition a horse appears to be unfit to continue, it may be eliminated on the authority of the veterinary surgeon or steward appointed for that purpose.
7. Horses may only be exercised in the area provided & riders must wear a crash helmet.
8. In the event of a tie the prize money will be divided.
9. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
10. There will be a £5 deposit on competitors' numbers, and £10 for team chase numbers.
11. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organizers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organizers nor any agent, employee or representative of the Avon Vale Hunt accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
12. In the absence of anything to the contrary "British Eventing" Rules will apply.
13. The course will be open for walking, from 2:00 pm on Friday 2nd April 2010
